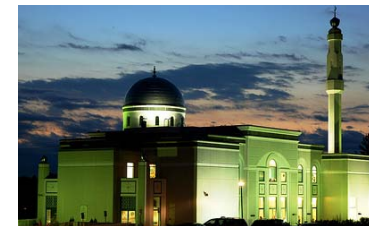

GUIDELINES

- ◆ **All competitions:** Names of competitors should be submitted through respective Regional Nāzim by Friday 8:00 PM. One competitor or team from each region for competitions listed below except Table tennis:
- ◆ **General & Religious Knowledge:** One 4-member team per region
- ◆ **Qir'atul Qur'an:** Chapter 88 (Al-Infitar) Verses 1 to 6.
- ◆ **Hadith Competition:** Hadith Number 11 (The High Concept of Obedience in Islām) from Forty Gems of Beauty. (3 minutes)
- ◆ **Impromptu Speech:** (3 minutes)
- ◆ **Message Relay:** 5 members per team.
- ◆ **Table Tennis Competition:** Up to 3 competitors per age-group per region.
- ◆ **Volleyball and Tug-of-War Competitions:** Only one team per region.
